



### IT'S A WRAP | GOLD

A tall order, no question: The designer was commissioned to “define the look and feel” of a 4,000-square-foot addition and to integrate modern detailing into the existing house. The owners hoped to warm up their East Bay nest, not detract from its cinematic water views. Taylor adeptly did just that, devising a killer kitchen filled with custom cabinetry and introducing heady eye-pleasing materials like porcelain and gold-leaf glass mosaic tiles, onyx and stone. An impressive variety of woods – among them maple floors, mahogany doors, makore, bamboo and walnut – enrich but never overpower. The modern furnishings, many of them Italian or French, settle comfortably with the wood tones so that the final picture is as it should be – one cohesive, perfect whole, from serene palette to texture-providing finishes and fixtures.
